Two original members moved on to other things and their replacements have brought with them a renewed energy and dynamic, and a new name.

30 years down the road ROCK66 keeps the spirit of the early days of rock 'n' roll and mixes it up with a drive towards a faithful and energetic presentation of the songs we love to hear.
